
This is a parrot fish. Below is the living coral!




Here is some more living coral. It's hard and sharp.

This clownfish (Nemo) is hiding in a sea anemone.




Brain coral looks like a brain. This is brain coral.




More brain coral and a swimming parrot fish.

What a magnificent picture of the reef, in my opinion!




This is Tylar's favorite picture of a parrot fish.
